Declaring Lands in North Auckland and Taranaki Land Districts Vested in the Auckland and Taranaki Education Boards as Sites for Public Schools to be Vested in Her Majesty the Queen

#### C. W. M. NORRIE, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

A PROCLAMATION WHEREAS by subsection (6) of section 5 of the Education Lands Act 1949 (hereinafter referred to as the said Act) it is provided that, notwithstanding anything contained in any other Act, the Governor-General may from time to time, by Proclamation, declare that any school site or part of a school site which in his opinion is no longer required for that purpose shall be vested in Her Majesty, and thereupon the school site, or part thereof, as the case may be, shall vest in her Majesty, freed and discharged from every educational trust affecting the same, but subject to all leases, encum-brances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the date of the Proclamation: Now, therefore, pursuant to subsection (6) of section 5 of

of the Proclamation: Now, therefore, pursuant to subsection (6) of section 5 of the said Act, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the lands described in the First Schedule hereto, being areas vested in the Auckland Educa-tion Board, and the land described in the Second Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the Taranaki Education Board, as sites for public schools, shall be vested in Her Majesty the Queen, freed and discharged from every educational trust affecting the same, but subject to all leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the date hereof.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE

NORTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

Lots 1 and 2, D.P. 23916, being part Allotment 30 of Section 8, Suburbs of Auckland, situated in Block XVI, Waitemata Survey District: Total area, 3 roods 9 5 perches, more or less. Part certificate of title, Volume 245, folio 28.
