Declaring Land to be Crown Land

C. W. M. NORRIE, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

Pursuant to section 265 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land and to be subject to the Land Act 1948.

SCHEDULE

WELLINGTON LAND DISTRICT

ALL that piece of land containing 212 acres, more or less, being the block of land known as Rangataua North 2B 2B, situated in Block I, Karioi Survey District, as shown on the plan marked L. and S. 4/362/1 deposited in the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey at Wellington, and thereon edged red (W.D. 4225).
