IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Kaitaia Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of £15,000 authorised to be raised by the said Kaitaia Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of developing and constructing a sewerage disposal scheme within the Borough of Kaitaia, the said Kaitaia Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of 0.50 of one penny in one pound (£1) on all rateable property of the Borough of Kaitaia; and that such rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Auckland City Council hereby resolves as follows:
