PURSUANT to the Land and Income Tax Act 1954, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Land and Income Tax Payment Order 1957.

2. This order applies to land tax and income tax for the year of assessment commencing on the 1st day of April 1957.

3. Land tax shall be due and payable in one sum on the 17th day of September 1957.

4. Income tax shall be due and payable in one sum on the 6th day of February 1958.

5. Land tax and income tax shall be payable at any office of the Taxes Division, Inland Revenue Department, or at any money-order post office.

PURSUANT to section 254 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby varies an Order in Council made on 14 March 1932, and published in the *Gazette*, 17 March 1932, Volume I, page 546, prohibiting all alienations of the Maori land known as Hauhungaroa 1A 1 and other blocks, other than alienations in favour of the Crown, by excluding therefrom the lands described in the Schedule hereto.

Setting Apart Maori Freehold Land as a Maori Reservation

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 439 of the Maori Affairs Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby sets apart the Maori freehold land described in the Schedule hereto for the common use and benefit of the members of the Ngati Takihuhu Tribe as a Maori reservation for the purposes of a meeting place.

SCHEDULE

WELLINGTON LAND DISTRICT

ALL that area of land situated in Block XIV, Mount Robinson Survey District, containing 2 roods 19.3 perches, and being all of the land known as Manawatu Kukutauaki No. 3 Section 1A 2B 2C; as is more particularly delineated on the plan numbered M.L. 4599 lodged in the office of the Chief Surveyor, Wellington.
