

*Licensing the Ngakuta Boating Club to Use and Occupy Part of the Foreshore at Ngakuta Bay, Queen Charlotte Sound as a Site for a Jetty*

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, the Minister of Marine hereby licenses and permits the Ngakuta Boating Club (hereinafter called the licensee, which term shall include its successors or assigns, unless the context requires a different construction) to use and occupy a part of the foreshore and land below low-water mark at Ngakuta Bay in Queen Charlotte Sound, as shown on plan marked M.D., 8641 and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, for the purpose of maintaining thereon a jetty as shown on the said plan, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the licensee upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

1. This licence is subject to the Foreshore Licence Regulations 1940, and the provisions of those regulations shall, so far as applicable, apply hereto.

2. The term of the licence shall be fourteen years from the 1st day of July 1957.

3. The premium payable by the licensee shall be two pounds (£2) and the annual sum so payable three pounds (£3).

4. The master of every vessel discharging ballast at the said jetty shall have all such ballast taken away and deposited above high-water mark or at such place as may be approved by the Minister or by any person appointed by the Minister for that purpose.
