

## AUCKLAND CITY COUNCIL

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Auckland City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £700,000 to be known as the Works Loan 1957 authorised to be raised by the Auckland City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of carrying out street, drainage, and miscellaneous works in the City of Auckland and the cost of raising the loan, the said Auckland City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of two and one-seventh pence (2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>7</sub>d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the annual value) of all rateable property in the City of Auckland, comprising the whole of the City of Auckland; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

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## MANIOTOTO COUNTY COUNCIL

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Maniototo County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £26,000 authorised to be raised by the Maniototo County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the erection of houses and garages and purchasing land, the said Maniototo Council hereby makes a special rate of one-sixth (1/6th) of a penny in the pound on the rateable value of all rateable property of the County of Maniototo; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 15th day of August in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

The foregoing resolution was passed at a special meeting of the Maniototo County Council held on the 26th day of July 1957.

## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND
