NORTH SHORE DRAINAGE BOARD

SPECIAL ORDER

Northcote Drainage Loan 1956, £42,000

THE North Shore Drainage Board doth hereby, in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the North Shore Drainage Act 1951 and its amendments, and in pursuance of the authority conferred on it under the Local Bodies' Finance Act 1921-22, the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1925, the Local Government Loans Board Act 1926, and their respective amendments, and in exercise of all other powers enabling it in that behalf, resolve by special resolution intended to operate as a special order to borrow the sum of forty-two thousand pounds (£42,000) for the purpose of the construction of a sewage scheme for portion of Northcote Borough.

The foregoing special order was made by way of a special resolution passed at a special meeting of the North Shore Drainage Board convened by requisition of the chairman and held on 3 December 1956. It was publicly notified in the *New Zealand Herald* on 20 December 1956 and 7 January 1957. It was confirmed at a meeting of the Board convened by resolution of the Board on 3 December 1956 and held on 14 January 1957.

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GISBORNE CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Gisborne City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £200,000 authorised to be raised by the Gisborne City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of providing for the disposal of sewage to Papatuariki Point and Tuamotu Island, the said Gisborne City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one and nineteen one hundred and twenty-eighths pence ($1^{19}/128$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the City of Gisborne; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of thirty-five years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
