

*Authorising the Laying Off of Burnton Street (Extension) and Pinny Avenue (Extension) in the City of Lower Hutt, of Widths Less Than 66 ft., Subject to Conditions as to Building Line*

PURSUANT to section 186 of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 and section 125 of the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby authorises the Lower Hutt City Council to permit the laying off of the proposed street first described in the Schedule hereto of a width of less than 66 ft., but not less than 50 ft., subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting that proposed street within a distance of 40 ft. from the centre line of that street, and the proposed street secondly described in the Schedule hereto at a width of less than 66 ft., but not less than 40 ft., subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting that proposed street within a distance of 35 ft. from the centre line of that street.

PURSUANT to section 186 of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, and section 125 of the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby authorises the Hawera Borough Council to lay off the proposed streets described in the Schedule hereto to be known as Bone Crescent and Pacey Avenue at a width for part of their lengths of less than 66 ft., and not less than 50 ft.; as Reid Avenue at a width of less than 66 ft., but not less than 49 ft. 4 in.; and as Sutton Place at a width for part of its length of less than 66 ft., but not less than 40 ft., subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on Lots 26 and 27 of a subdivision of the land shown edged green on the plan referred to in the Schedule hereto within a distance of 8 ft. from the side lines of the said Sutton Place, or of 15 ft. from the side line of the said Reid Avenue, or on the balance of the land in the said subdivision within a distance of 15 ft. from the side lines of the said streets.
