WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Wellington City Buildings Loan 1957 of £25,000

THE following resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Wellington City Council held on the 2nd day of September 1957:

Pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on the loan of twenty-five thousand pounds (£25,000) to be known as the Wellington City Buildings Loan 1957 authorised to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of carrying out alterations to the Kings and Empire Chambers, the Wellington City Council hereby makes a special rate of twelve/eight-hundredths of a penny (12/800d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the City of Wellington; and that the said special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the said loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the said loan, being a period not exceeding twenty (20) years, or until the said loan is fully paid off."

WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Wellington City Electricity Loan No. 1, 1957, of £250,000

THE following resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Wellington City Council held on the 2nd day of September 1957:

Pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on the loan of two hundred and fifty thousand pounds (£250,000) to be known as the Wellington City Electricity Loan No. 1, 1957, authorised to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of extending the Council's electrical distribution system, the Wellington City Council hereby makes a special rate of one hundred and nineteen/eight-hundredths of a penny (119/800d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the City of Wellington; and that the said special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the said loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the said loan, being a period not exceeding twenty (20) years, or until the said loan is fully paid off."

TAURANGA ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities' Loans Act 1956 and all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Tauranga Electric Power Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of the principal and interest and other charges in respect of the Tauranga Electric Power Board Electrical Extension Loan 1956, £100,000, authorised to be raised by the Tauranga Electric Power Board by special order under the Local Authorities' Loans Act 1956 for the purpose of providing additional moneys for further reticulating the Tauranga Electric Power District, the Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of 2/7ths of a penny in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Tauranga Electric Power District; and that such special rate shall be payable annually on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
