## SCHEDULE

## OTAGO LAND DISTRICT

ALL these separate parcels of land in the Provincial District of Otago, containing by admeasurement a total acreage of 1 acre 2 roods, more or less, situate in the Township of Kaitangata:

Firstly, all that portion to the west of Water Street opposite Blocks XXXIV, XXIII, and XXIV of said town, containing by admeasurement 2 roods, more or less. Bounded towards the west and north-west by the Kaitangata Creek, 1800 links; and towards the north-east by Water Street, 1600 links.

Secondly, all that portion to the west of Water Street opposite Blocks XXV and XXVI of said town, containing by admeasurement 1 rood, more or less. Bounded towards the west and north-west by the Kaitangata Creek, 1000 links; and towards the north-east and south-east by Water Street, 950 links.

Thirdly, all that portion to the west of Water Street opposite Block XXVII of said town, containing by admeasurement 12 perches, more or less. Bounded towards the west and north-west by the Kaitangata Creek, 350 links; and towards the south-east by Water Street, 340 links.

Sixthly, all that portion to the west of Water Street opposite Blocks XXIX and XXX of said town, containing by admeasurement 1 rood, more or less. Bounded towards the south-west, west, and north-west by the Kaitangata Creek, 950 links; towards the north-east by Water Street, 830 links; and towards the south-east by Water Street, 30 links: be all the aforesaid linkages more or less.
