The licence hereby conferred is subject to compliance by the licensee with the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, the Radio Interference Regulations 1934, and with all regulations hereafter made in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor respectively.

SYSTEM OF SUPPLY

3. The system of supply shall be as described in paragraphs (a) and (d) of regulation 21-01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, and shall be an alternating-current system.

DURATION OF LICENCE

4. Unless sooner lawfully determined, this licence shall con-tinue in force until the 31st day of March 1978 or until electrical energy is available from an electric power board or some other public source of supply, whichever is the earlier.

CHARGES ON SALE

5. The charge for the sale of electrical energy shall not exceed 1s. per kWh, or $\pounds 1$ 15s. per year for each 100 watts of installed capacity.
