PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby grants to the Egmont National Park Board (hereinafter referred to as the licensee), a licence, subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, to take and use from the Kapuni Stream (hereinafter referred to as and use from the Kapuni Stream (hereinafter referred to as the said stream), situated near Dawson Falls Hostel in the Egmont National Park, Kaupokonui Survey District, in the County of Stratford, for the purpose hereinafter set forth, a stream of water not exceeding three cubic feet per second at any one time.

# CONDITIONS

# IMPLIED CONDITIONS

1. The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Water Power Regulations 1934 and the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 shall be incorporated in and shall form part of this licence except in so far as the same may be inconsistent with the provisions hereof.

#### LICENCE SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS

. This licence is issued under the Water Power Regulations 1934, and is subject thereto, and to the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, the Radio Interference Regulations 1934, and to all regulations hereafter made in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor respectively.

# Utilisation of Water and Location of Headworks

3. Water shall be used under this licence solely for the purpose of generating electricity and shall be taken from the said stream at a point near Dawson Falls Hostel in the Egmont National Park, Kaupokonui Survey District.
