The Glenbervie Rural Fire District Order 1957

PURSUANT to the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Glenbervie Rural Fire District Order 1957.

2. This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

3. The area specified in the Schedule to this order is hereby constituted and declared to be a rural fire district to be known as the Glenbervie Rural Fire District.

4. The trees and other plants on State forest land situated in the said area are hereby specified as the property for the protection of which the district is constituted.

5. The Glenbervie Rural Fire District shall, for the purposes of the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1955, be administered by the Minister of Forests.

6. The period between the 1st day of October in any year and the 30th day of April in the following year is hereby specified and declared to be a closed fire season in the said district.

SCHEDULE

AREA INCLUDED IN THE GLENBERVIE RURAL FIRE DISTRICT

ALL that area in the North Auckland Land District, Whangarei County, containing approximately 23,000 acres, situated in Block XVI, Hukerenui Survey District, Blocks XI and XII, Opuawhanga Survey District, Blocks V and VIII, Purua Survey District, and Blocks I, II, and V, Whangarei Survey District, and bounded generally as follows:

Towards the north-west by Hikurangi Town District, Allotments S.W. 46, N.E. 46, S.W. 48, N.E. 48, Hikurangi Parish, Section 6, Block XVI, Hukerenui Survey District, and by a right line from the north-eastern corner of the aforesaid section to the south-western corner of Section 34, Block XI, Opuawhanga Survey District; towards the north by Section 34, Block XI aforesaid; towards the east by Section 9A, Block XI aforesaid; towards the north by Sections 9A and 9, Block XI aforesaid; towards the west by Sections 9 and 8, Block XI aforesaid; towards the north generally by Sections 3, 4, 23, 20, and 12, Block XI aforesaid; thence by a road intersecting Section 12, Block XI aforesaid, and Section 1, Block XII, Opuawhanga Survey District, and by Section 11, Block XII aforesaid; thence towards the north-east by a right line from the south-eastern corner of Section 11 aforesaid to the north-western corner of Section 27, Block XII aforesaid; towards the east by Sections 27 and 26, Block XII aforesaid; towards the north generally by Neill's Road and Sections 32 and 21, Block XII aforesaid; towards the east generally by the Ngunguru River, part of Section 1, Block III, Whangarei Survey District, a quarry reserve by the eastern side of the Kiripaka-Ngunguru road and again by the Ngunguru River; towards the south-east generally by the southern side of the Kiripapa Road, the Te Kohao and Kotaiha Blocks, and the Hatea River; towards the south-west generally by Allotment 14, Whangarei Parish, and the south-western side of Vinegar Hill Road; and towards the north and west by Hikurangi Town District. As shown on plan No. 9/38 deposited in the Head Office of the New Zealand Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered red.

Eyrewell Rural Fire District Order 1948, Amendment No. 1

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Eyrewell Rural Fire District Order 1948, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the order constituting the Eyrewell Rural Fire District made on 24 November 1948* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. The principal order may hereinafter be cited as the Eyrewell Rural Fire District Order 1948.

3. The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by omitting the Schedule thereto and substituting the Schedule set out in the Schedule to this order.

"SCHEDULE

"CANTERBURY LAND DISTRICT—CANTERBURY CONSERVANCY
EYREWELL RURAL FIRE DISTRICT

"ALL that area in Oxford and Eyre Counties, containing approximately 65,000 acres, situated in Oxford, Mairaki, Rangiora, Hawkins, Rolleston, and Christchurch Survey Districts, and bounded generally as follows: towards the north-east by the north-eastern side of Eyre Road South; towards the east and north by Rural Section 9607; towards the east by the eastern side of Harrs Road and by this road side produced to the left bank of the Waimakariri River; thence by a right line due south to the right bank of the Waimakariri River; towards the south generally by the aforesaid right bank of the Waimakariri River to a point in line with the western boundary of Rural Section 32080; towards the north-west by a right line to the westernmost corner of Rural Section 32080 aforesaid, by the western boundary of the last-mentioned section, by a right line from the northernmost corner of the said section to the junction of Thongcaster Road with the western side of the water-race reserve in Block III, Hawkins Survey District, and by the said western side of the water-race reserve to and across the Eyre Road South. As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 143/24 deposited in the Head Office of the New Zealand Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered red."
