PURSUANT to section 112 of the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby orders and declares that the portions of road described in the Schedule hereto shall, on and after the date of this Order in Council, become a county road.

SCHEDULE

FIRST, all that portion of road in the North Auckland Land District, situated in Block VII, Kerikeri Survey District, Bay of Islands County, commencing at the south-eastern corner of Section 4, Block VII of the aforesaid Survey District, and proceeding thence in a northerly direction generally for a distance of approximately 24 chains and terminating at the north-eastern corner of the aforesaid Section 4.

Secondly, all that portion of road in the North Auckland Land District, situated in Blocks VII and VIII, Kerikeri Survey District, Bay of Islands County, commencing at the south-western boundary of Section 5, Block VII of the aforesaid Survey District, approximately 6 chains north-east of the north-eastern corner of Section 4, Block VII of the aforesaid Survey District, and proceeding thence in a north-easterly direction generally for a distance of approximately 172 chains and terminating at the north-western corner of Section 23, Block VIII, Kerikeri Survey District.

Thirdly, all that portion of road in the North Auckland Land District, situated in Block VIII, Kerikeri Survey District, Bay of Islands County, commencing at the westernmost corner of Section 23 of the aforesaid Block VIII, and proceeding thence in a south-easterly direction generally for a distance of approximately 83 chains and terminating at the southernmost corner of the aforesaid Section 23.
