A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 29 of the Public Works Amendment Act 1948, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim as road the land described in the First Schedule hereto; and also hereby proclaim and declare that the portion of road described in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby closed and added to the land now held for a public school described in the Third Schedule hereto.

#### FIRST SCHEDULE

##### LAND PROCLAIMED AS ROAD

ALL that piece of land in the Canterbury Land District containing 25.3 perches, situated in Block IV, Akaroa Survey District, Canterbury R.D., being part Reserve 4834; coloured sepia on plan.

#### SECOND SCHEDULE

##### ROAD CLOSED

ALL that piece of road in the Canterbury Land District containing 1 rood 2.9 perches, situated in Block IV, Akaroa Survey District, Canterbury R.D., and adjoining Town Sections 130 and 130x, Town of Akaroa, Reserves 53x and 4834, part Reserve 53, Lot 1, D.P. 6474, being part Rural Section 61, and part Lot 1, D.P. 4491, being part Rural Section 61; coloured green on plan.
