COBHAM, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the Crown land described in the First Schedule hereto and the land described in the Second Schedule hereto, now held for a gravel pit, is hereby set apart for a public school; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 13th day of January 1958.

FIRST SCHEDULE

ALL that piece of Crown land in the Canterbury Land District containing 9 acres and 28 9 perches, situated in Block VI, Culverden Survey District, Canterbury R.D., being Section 43, Culverden Settlement; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 155098 (S.O. 9256) deposited in the office of the Minister of Works at Wellington, and thereon edged red.
