Amending Declaration of Land, Rotorua Acclimatisation District, as a Wildlife Refuge

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Warrant published in *Gazette*, 17 September 1931, page 2817, relating to the Rotorua Acclimatisation District notifying and declaring certain areas to be sanctuaries under the Animals Protection and Game Act 1921-22, to the extent appearing in the First Schedule hereto and I hereby proclaim and declare the areas of land described in the Second Schedule hereto to be wildlife refuges for the purposes of the Wildlife Act 1953.

FIRST SCHEDULE

AREAS REVOKED AS SANCTUARIES UNDER THE ANIMALS PROTECTION AND GAMES ACT 1921-22

AREA at Hamurana: All that area comprising the Hamurana Stream and that portion of Lake Rotorua within a radius of half a mile from where such a stream enters the said lake.

Matata Lagoon: All that area in the Auckland Land District containing by admeasurement 108 acres, being Section 4, Block VI, Awa-o-te-Atua Survey District, known as Matata Lagoon.
