

## SECOND SCHEDULE

## AREAS DECLARED TO BE WILDLIFE REFUGES UNDER THE WILDLIFE ACT 1953

1. Area at Hamurana: All that area of approximately 280 acres in Blocks V and IX, Rotoiti Survey District, being the whole of the Hamurana Stream, and the part of Lake Rotorua within a radius of half a mile of the middle of the mouth of that stream.

As the same is shown on plan marked I.A. 52/28 deposited in the Head Office, Department of Internal Affairs, Wellington, and thereon edged red.

2. Matata Lagoon: All that area of 108 acres, more or less, known as the Matata Lagoon, being Section 4, Block VI, Awaateatua Survey District, C.S.O. Plan 24616.

As the same is shown on plan marked I.A. 52/60 deposited in the Head Office, Department of Internal Affairs, Wellington, and thereon edged red.
