Livestock in Crates—5. Calves (not exceeding six months old), sheep, pigs, or goats properly secured in crates so as to prevent damage to other goods will be charged as follows:

Gross Weight per Crate	Rate
Not exceeding 3 cwt.	Class C plus 50%
Exceeding 3 cwt.	Class C double rate
