RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Electrical Reticulation Loan 1958, £20,000—First Issue of £10,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Rangiora Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of paying the annual charges on a loan of £10,000, being the first issue of the Electrical Reticulation Loan 1958 of £20,000, authorised to be raised by the Rangiora Borough Council under the above Act for the purpose of further reticulating the Council's district, the Rangiora Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal four two pence (.42d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the whole of the Borough of Rangiora; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of fifteen (15) years, or until the loan is paid off."

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Street Works Loan 1958, £16,000—First Issue of £8,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Rangiora Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £8,000, being the first issue of the Street Works Loan 1958 of £16,000, authorised to be raised by the Rangiora Borough Council under the above Act for the purpose of street reconstruction, sealing, kerbing and channelling, footpath formation, and sealing, the Rangiora Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of decimal two eight pence (.28d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the whole of the Borough of Rangiora; and that the special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty (20) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

BRUCE COUNTY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Rural Housing Loan 1958, £16,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Bruce County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £16,000 authorised to be raised by the Bruce County Council for the purpose of making advances to farmers under the Rural Housing Act 1939, the Council hereby makes a special rate of one-thirtieth (1/30) of a penny in the £ upon the rateable capital value of all rateable property of the county, and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan, and be payable half-yearly as the payments fall due in each and every half-year during the currency of the loan, being a period of thirty years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

The foregoing is a true copy of a resolution passed at a meeting of the Bruce County Council on the 12th day of March 1958, and confirmed at a meeting on the 14th day of May 1958.
