Pursuant to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby set apart, together with the benefit of and subject to a party-wall easement created in and by memorandum of transfer No. 24370, Gisborne Land Registry, for public buildings of the General Government; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 23rd day of June 1958.
