HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 186 of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954 and section 125 of the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby authorises the Henderson Borough Council to permit the laying off of the proposed street described in the Schedule hereto at a width for part of its length of less than 66 ft, but not less than 50 ft, subject to the condition that no building or any part of a building shall at any time be erected on a subdivision of the land shown edged green on the plan marked P.W.D. 156766 referred to in the said Schedule, within a distance of 33 ft from the centre line of the said street.
