

Licensing Mr D. A. Norman to Use and Occupy a Part of the Foreshore in Whangamata Harbour as a Site for a Slipway

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, the Minister of Marine hereby licenses and permits Douglas Alexander Norman (hereinafter called the licensee, which term shall include his administrators, executors, or assigns, unless the context requires a different construction) to use and occupy a part of the foreshore and land below low-water mark in Whangamata Harbour, as shown on plan marked M.D. 10434 and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, for the purpose of erecting and maintaining thereon a slipway as shown on the said plan, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the licensee upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

1. This licence is subject to the Foreshore Licence Regulations 1940 and the provisions of those regulations shall, so far as applicable, apply hereto.

2. The term of the licence shall be 14 years from the 1st day of October 1958.

3. The premium payable by the licensee shall be five pounds (£5) and the annual sum so payable ten pounds (£10).
