Pursuant to subsection (6) of section 5 of the Education Cands Act 1949, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim, and declare that the lands described in the Schedule hereto, being areas vested in the Otago Education Board as sites for public schools, shall be vested in Her Majesty the Queen, freed and lischarged from every educational trust affecting the same, sut subject to all leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the date hereof
