Land Set Apart as Provisional State Forest Declared to be Subject to the Land Act 1948

#### COBHAM, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

A PROCLAMATION PURSUANT to subsection (2) of section 19 of the Forests Act 1949, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, acting on the joint recommendation of the Minister of Lands and of the Minister of Forests, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being provisional State forest reserve set apart by Proclamation dated the 28th day of October 1952, and published in *Gazette*, 6 November 1952, Volume III, page 1805, is required for settlement purposes; and in accord-ance with the provisions of the said Act such land shall, from and after the day of the gazetting hereof, cease to be pro-visional State forest land and shall become Crown land avail-able for sale, lease, reservation, or other disposition under the able for sale, lease, reservation, or other disposition under the provisions of the Land Act 1948.
