## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

*Stormwater Drainage Loan 1958, £5,000*

THAT in the pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Lower Hutt City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of five thousand pounds (£5,000) authorised to be raised by the Lower Hutt City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of installing stormwater drainage in the vicinity of Whites Line East, the said Lower Hutt City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of seventy-seven thousandths of a penny (0.77d.) in the pound (£) on the rateable value (on the basis of the annual value) of all rateable property in the City of Lower Hutt; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on or about the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 10 years, or until the loan is paid off."

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

*Streets Extension Loan (No. 4) 1958, £13,500*

THAT in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Lower Hutt City Council hereby resolved as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of thirteen thousand five hundred pounds (£13,500) authorised to be raised by the Lower Hutt City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of constructing Riverside Drive between Naenae Road and Rungay Street, the said Lower Hutt City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one hundred and forty-eight thousandths of a penny (0.148d.) in the pound (£) on the rateable value (on the basis of the annual value) of all rateable property in the City of Lower Hutt and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on or about the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of 25 years, or until the loan is paid off."

## MARLBOROUGH CATCHMENT BOARD

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

*Office and Depot Establishment Loan 1958, £12,000*

THE following resolution was passed at a meeting of the Marlborough Catchment Board held on the 11th day of November 1958:

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941, and all other powers in that behalf enabling, the Marlborough Catchment Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £12,000, known as the Office and Depot Establishment Loan 1958, authorised to be raised by the Marlborough Catchment Board under the above-mentioned Acts for the purpose of constructing an office block, workshop, and store building, the said Board hereby makes and levies a special rate, decimal nought one five five of a penny (0.155d.) in the pound (£) on the rateable capital value of all rateable property within the Marlborough Catchment District as defined in the *Gazette*, No. 58, dated 15 September 1955, at page 1429; and that such special rate shall be an annual rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 20 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
