PURSUANT to section 34 of the Statutes Amendment Act 1940, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council:

1. Hereby revokes the Orders in Council dated 11 September 1957 and 11 November 1957 and published in *Gazette* of 1957, at pages 1675 and 2185; and

2. Hereby further orders and declares that from and after the date hereof no mining privileges in respect of the lands described in the Schedule hereto or of any part thereof shall be granted without the previous written consent of the Minister of Mines nor shall any mining privilege in respect of the said lands or any part thereof, whether granted before or after the date hereof be sold, leased, mortgaged, pledged, or otherwise disposed of or dealt with whether by the holder thereof or by the Official Assignee of any bankrupt holder or by the liquidator of any company or by a Sheriff under any execution or by any executor or administrator of a deceased holder without the previous written consent of the Minister of Mines.
