In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1926, the Bay of Islands County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of principal interest and other charges on a loan of seven thousand five hundred pounds (£7,500) authorised to be raised by the Bay of Islands County Council under the abovementioned Act for the purpose of financing the purchase of a power grader, the Bay of Islands County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of five sixteenths ($\frac{5}{16}$) of one penny in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the whole of the County of Bay of Islands; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of five (5) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
