PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that an easement is hereby taken for Education purposes over the land described in the First Schedule hereto, vesting in Her Majesty the Queen full and free right, liberty, licence, and authority in perpetuity to construct and use a right of way with the right for Her Majesty's servants, agents, and workmen from time to time and at all times hereafter to go, pass, and repass with or without horses or other animals or vehicles over the said land and to maintain, repair, and keep open the said right of way for the purpose of providing access to the land described in the Second Schedule hereto; and also hereby declare that the aforesaid easement shall be held appurtenant to the land in the Second Schedule hereto; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 16th day of March 1959.
