# COBHAM, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Proclamation dated the 19th day of November 1957, published in *Gazette*, 28 November 1957, Volume III, page 2213, and deposited in the Land Registry Office at Wellington as No. 5927, taking land for the purposes of Part II of the Housing Improvement Act 1945 in the City of Wellington, in so far as it affects the land described in the Schedule hereto, the land being no longer required.

#### **SCHEDULE**

#### WELLINGTON LAND DISTRICT

ALL that piece of land containing 14.3 perches, situated in the City of Wellington, Wellington R.D., being Lot 1, D.P. 770, being part Section 738, City of Wellington. All certificate of title, Volume 179, folio 125, Wellington Land Registry.

## COBHAM, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby alter the boundaries of the Bay of Plenty Electric Power District by including therein the areas described in the First, Second, and Third Schedules hereto, the boundaries as so altered being described in the Fourth Schedule hereto.

ALL that part of the Borough of Kawerau not already included in the Bay of Plenty Electric Power District.

THE Town District of Murupara.

#### THIRD SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, Counties of Tauranga and Rotorua, bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the western boundary of the Whakatane County with the northern boundary of Block XI, Waihi South Survey District, and proceeding southerly along that county boundary, as described in Gazette, 1957, page 808, to and westerly along the southern boundaries of Blocks VII and VI, Rotoma Survey District, to and along the eastern, southern, and western boundaries of Section 5, Block VI aforesaid, and continuing along the shores of Lake Rotoma, to and along the eastern and north-eastern boundaries of part Rotoiti, No. 10 Block, to and along the generally south-western side of Pongakawa Valley Road, to the northernmost corner of Section 8, Block VI aforesaid; thence along a right line across that road to and along the eastern boundary of State forest, set apart by Gazette, 1938, page 1687 (formerly Hannons' Road), to and along the north-western boundaries of Sections 2 and 1A, Block II, Rotoma Survey District aforesaid, to and down the middle of the Waitahanui Stream, to and easterly along the northern boundary of Blocks X and VI Woiki South Survey District tather and the server boundary and VI Woiki South Survey District tather and the server boundary and VI Woiki South Survey District tather and the server boundary and VI Woiki South Survey District tather and the server boundary and via Woiki South Survey District tather and via More Survey District tat to and easterly along the northern boundary of Blocks X and XI, Waihi South Survey District, to the point of commencement.
