BANKS PENINSULA ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATES

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Banks Peninsula Electric Power Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That for the purpose of providing annual charges on the under-mentioned loans, authorised to be raised by the Banks Peninsula Electric Power Board under the above Act, for the purposes specified below, the said Board hereby makes special rates as follows:

Loan	Term	Purpose	Special Rate
Buildings 1958, £6,500 ..	25 years ..	Purchasing land, erecting and purchasing dwellings	One-sixtieth of a penny in the pound (£1).
Development 1959, £30,000 ..	20 years ..	Reticulation of Board's District ..	One-twelfth of a penny in the pound (£1)."

Such special rates shall be on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Banks Peninsula Electric Power District and shall be annually recurring, payable yearly on the 1st day of July in each and every year during the currency of the loans as shown, or until the loans are fully paid off.
