RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Fire Station and Appliance Loan 1958, £5,500

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Helensville Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £5,500 authorised to be raised by the Helensville Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of erecting a new fire station and purchasing a new fire engine, the said Helensville Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of ten sixty-fourths pence (10/64d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Borough of Helensville, comprising the whole of the Borough of Helensville; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 15 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
