## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

*Pensioners' Cottages (Vogel Street) Loan 1959, £27,000*

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 and its amendments and all other powers in that behalf enabling, the Christchurch City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of twenty-seven thousand pounds (£27,000) authorised to be raised by the Christchurch City Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of providing accommodation for pensioners, the said Christchurch City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of two thousand six hundred and thirty-seven/200 hundred and fifty thousandths of a penny (2637/250000d.) in the pound (£.00004395) on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property comprised within the City of Christchurch; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate payable on demand during the currency of the said loan, being a period of thirty (30) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

The Christchurch City Council at a meeting held on the 18th day of May 1959 passed the above resolution.
