A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 6 of the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act 1945, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, hereby declare the parts of New Zealand described in the Schedule hereto to be a tribal district for the purposes of the said Act and do hereby assign to the said district the name "Waitara Tribal District".

WAITARA TRIBAL DISTRICT

ALL the area being the Borough of Waitara as described in the *Gazette* of 1928 at page 3157.

Declaring Lands in North Auckland and Southland Land Districts Vested in the Auckland and Southland Education Boards as Sites for Public Schools to be Vested in Her Majesty the Queen

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to subsection (6) of section 5 of the Education Lands Act 1949, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the Auckland Education Board, and the land described in the Second Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the Southland Education Board, as sites for public schools shall be vested in Her Majesty the Queen, freed and discharged from every educational trust affecting the same, but subject to all leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the date hereof.

FIRST SCHEDULE
