ORDER

(1) This order may be cited as the Eketahuna Rabbit District Order 1959.
 (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the

date of its notification in the Gazette.

2. The boundaries of the Eketahuna Rabbit District, which was constituted by Order in Council on the 15th day of May 1946,* are hereby altered and redefined; and as from the commencement of this order the boundaries of the said district shall be those specified in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE
