

AKAROA COUNTY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Bridge Replacement Loan 1959, £7,840

In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 and amendments thereto, the Akaroa County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £7,740 authorised to be raised by the Akaroa County Council under the provisions of the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of replacing two bridges, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of point nought four one of a penny (.041d.) in the pound upon the rateable value of all the rateable property comprising the whole of the County of Akaroa; such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being for a period of thirty (30) years, or until the loan is wholly paid off."

AN ACT TO AMEND THE TRUSTEES, EXECUTORS, AND AGENCY Co. ACT 1882

NOTICE is hereby given that the Trustees, Executors, and Agency Co. of New Zealand Ltd. intends to apply for leave to bring into the House of Representatives, at the present session, a Private Bill the short title of which is the Trustees, Executors, and Agency Co. Amendment Act 1959.

The object of the proposed Bill is to amend section 14 of the Trustees, Executors, and Agency Company Act 1882 to provide that, in the event of the company altering the nominal value of the shares constituting its share capital, the liability of members of the company to contribute on a winding up of the company shall be correspondingly altered.
