

*Allocating Land Acquired for Railway Purposes at Waihao Downs to the Purposes of a Road*

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 226 of the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto shall, upon the publication hereof in the *Gazette*, become a road; and that the said road shall be under the control of the Waimate County Council and shall be maintained by the said Council in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said Council.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land allocated to street: 2 roads 29.4 perches.

Railway land, being part D.P. 818 (Sheet 7), being part Rural Section 22167, situated in Block I, Waitaki Survey District, Waimate County. (S.O. 9534.)

*Extending the Duration of Licences Authorising the Westland Electric Power Board to Use Water for the Purpose of Generating Electricity and to Erect and Use Electric Lines*

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby further amends the Orders in Council specified in the Schedule hereto, authorising the Westland Electric Power Board to use water for the purpose of generating electricity and to erect and use electric lines, the powers vested or conferred by the said Orders in Council having been delegated to Westland Power Ltd. and the duration of the said Orders in Council having been extended until the 4th day of July 1959 by an Order in Council dated the 24th day of June 1957 and published in the *Gazette* on the 4th day of July 1957, at page 1251, by further extending the duration of the said Orders in Council until the 4th day of July 1960.
