At the Government House at Wellington this 8th day of July 1959

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 128 of the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby approve of the resolution passed by the Auckland City Council on the 18th day of August 1958, and set out in the First Schedule hereto, in so far as it affects the sides and portions of street described in the Second Schedule hereto.

FIRST SCHEDULE

THE Auckland City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets of the City of Auckland, by resolution declares that the provisions of section 128 of the Public Works Act 1928 shall not apply to portions of the south-eastern side of York Street, the south-western side of Bradford Street and the north-western side of Earle Street, fronting parts of Allotment 64, Section 1, Suburbs of Auckland, and comprised in certificates of title, Volume 584, folio 105; Volume 584, folio 120, and Volume 11, folio 203, and shown coloured red on plan A. 2486/2.

SECOND SCHEDULE

NORTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

THE south-eastern side of all that portion of York Street in the City of Auckland, fronting part Allotment 64, Section 1, Suburbs of Auckland.

THE south-western side of all that portion of Bradford Street in the City of Auckland, fronting part Allotment 64, Section 1, Suburbs of Auckland.

THE north-western side of all that portion of Earle Street in the City of Auckland, fronting part Allotment 64, Section 1, Suburbs of Auckland.
