121 (1)	Royal jelly and preparations (not being foodstuffs or toilet preparations) containing royal jelly NOTE—Royal jelly is classed under the “Chemicals and chemical preparations” portion of Tariff item 121 (1) and is therefore NOT admissible under Tariff item 121 (2) as a medicinal preparation when imported in hermetically sealed glass vessels of a capacity not exceeding 15 c.c.	278-4/587

PART IV—AMENDMENTS TO NEW PAGES

- The following amendments to the new pages of the decision book, are to be made—
- Page 137A “Brushes, nail” – should be “Brushes, noil”.
 - Page 189A “Butyraldoxine” – General rate should be 3%.
 - Page 198 “Buckles, flat, double clamp” should be deleted (see page 198A).
 - Page 200 “Methyl cyclohexanol” should be “Methyl cyclohexanol”.
 - Page 203 “Cards, plain rectangular . . . ledger cards (T.O. 273)” – General rate should be 25%.
 - Page 204 “Counter check book paper . . .” – insert rates 3% : 3%.
 - Page 204B “Floats, copper, cylindrical . . .” insert rates 3% : 3%.
 - Page 205B “Oxirane H5” – should be “Oxirané HS”.
 - Page 206 “Sextate” – rates of duty should be 3% : 10%.
 - Page 207 “Overlays, being small pieces of timber . . .” – General rate should be 25%.
 - Page 212 “Twines, 2-16 ply . . .” – Insert rates 3% : 20%.
 - Page 214A “Glues, other than of animal origin” – Insert rates 3% : 3%.
