> COBHAM, Governor-General By his Deputy, J. D. HUTCHISON A PROCLAMATION

A PROCLAMATION PURSUANT to subsection (6) of section 5 of the Education Lands Act 1949, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the lands described in the First Schedule hereto, being areas vested in the Canterbury Education Board and the land described in the Second Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the Otago Education Board, as sites for public schools, shall be vested in Her Majesty the Queen, freed and discharged from every educational trust affecting the same, but subject to all leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the date hereof.

FIRST SCHEDULE

WESTLAND LAND DISTRICT

RESERVE 1822, situated in Block X, Waimea Survey District: Area, 1 rood 29.9 perches, more or less. (S.O. Plan 4317.)
