"That, for the purpose of providing for the repayment of an advance from its County Fund Account authorised to be made by the Makara County Council under the abovementioned Act for the purpose of providing a water supply to properties in Malvern Road, the said Makara County Council hereby makes a separate rate of four and two-tenths pence (4·2d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the Malvern Road Water Supply Area, which properties are identified by reference to District Valuation Roll Nos. 1642/254-258 inclusive, 1642/260-262 inclusive, and 1642/266-269 inclusive, and that the separate rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the advance and be payable yearly on the 16th day of September in each and every year during the currency of the advance, being a period of 10 years, or until the advance is fully paid off."
