A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 11 of the Reserves and Other Lands Disposal Act 1955, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that as from the 25th day of February 1959 the lands described in the Schedule hereto, shall be deemed to be vested in Her Majesty as Crown Land, subject to the provisions of the Land Act 1948.
