A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the middle line of a road to be constructed over Block VIII, Pohue Survey District, viz, a deviation of the Taupo-Napier Main Highway, shall be that defined and set forth in the Schedule hereto; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall effect only that land situated within the limits of the areas shown coloured red on the plan marked P.W.D. 159746 referred to in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

HAWKE'S BAY LAND DISTRICT

COMMENCING at a point on the centre line of the Taupo-Napier Main Highway, at route mileage 57·18, 1 mile 18 chains northwards by measurement along the middle of the existing highway, from the left bank end of the existing Mohaka River Bridge and proceeding thence generally in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 68 chains to the middle of the Mohaka River at a point 18·7 chains down stream from the existing Mohaka River Bridge; thence down stream along the middle of the said Mohaka River for a distance of approximately 33 chains; thence generally in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 24 chains along a right line to its intersection with the middle line of the new Mohaka River Bridge approach deviation at chainage 1 mile 47 chains, and passing in, into, through, or over the following lands, etc., viz, Tarawera Residue No. 1 Block, and part Section 5, Block VIII, Pohue Survey District, including all adjoining and intervening places, lands, reserves, roads, tracks, lakes, rivers, streams, and water courses; all in the Hawke's Bay Land District; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 159746 deposited in the office of the Minister of Works at Wellington.
