At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of August 1959

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby determines as follows:

1. This Order in Council shall come into force on the date of the next general election of the representatives of the constituent districts of the Wairarapa Electric Power District.

2. The number of representatives of each constituent district of the Wairarapa Electric Power District on the Wairarapa Electric Power Board shall be the number specified in the Schedule hereto opposite the name of that constituent district.

3. The first election of the representatives of part Masterton County shall be held on the date of the said next general election.

4. The Order in Council dated the 4th day of October 1950 and published in the *Gazette* on the 5th day of the same month at page 1810, reapportioning representation on the Wairarapa Electric Power Board, is hereby revoked.
