RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Drainage Extension Loan 1959 of £200,000

PURSUANT to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Dunedin Drainage and Sewerage Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £200,000 authorised to be raised by the Dunedin Drainage and Sewerage Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of extending the drainage system within the board's district and to provide for pumping station and other ancillary works, the said Dunedin Drainage and Sewerage Board hereby makes a special rate of 0·2179d. in the pound (£) upon the rateable value of all rateable property in the board's district, comprising the whole of the City of Dunedin and the Borough of St. Kilda; and that the special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 20 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

PIAKO COUNTY COUNCIL

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1953

PUBLIC notice is hereby given that, pursuant to a resolution of the Piako County Council on the 21st day of July 1958, a district scheme has been recommended for approval under the Town and Country Planning Act 1953. The scheme relates to the Waihou area and the area of the Piako County adjoining the Borough of Te Aroha, and is known as section 1 of the County's District Planning Scheme. The scheme has been deposited at the County office, Kenrick Street, Te Aroha, and is there open for inspection, without fee, to all persons interested therein at any time when the County office is open to the public.

Objections to the scheme or to any part thereof shall be in writing in the form No. 4 prescribed in the First Schedule to the Town and Country Planning Regulations 1954, and shall be lodged at the office of the County Council at any time not later than the 30th day of September 1959.
