Hawera Extensions Loan 1958, £62,000

THE following resolution was passed at a duly constituted meeting of the Hawera Borough Council, held at the Council Chambers, High Street, Hawera, on the 12th day of October 1959:

Pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956, the Hawera Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the annual charges on a loan of £62,000 authorised to be raised by the Hawera Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purposes of:

(a) Improving existing facilities for water and installing recording plant	27,000
(b) Improving and extending existing sewage reticulation and outfall	35,000
Total	£62,000

the said Hawera Borough Council hereby makes a special rate of seventy-seven one hundredths (.77) of a penny in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Hawera, comprising the whole of the Borough of Hawera (defined in *Gazette*, 1925, at page 1776, and altered by Order in Council recorded in *Gazette*, 1957, at page 2290); and that the special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of 25 years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
