PURSUANT to the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby determines as follows:

1. This Order in Council shall come into force on the date of the next general election of members of local authorities.
2. The constituent districts of the Hawke's Bay Electric Power District, which are bracketed together in the first column of the Schedule hereto, shall be a combined district for the purposes of the said Act.
3. The local authority of the constituent district distinguished in the first column of the Schedule hereto by the letter "(P)" shall be the principal local authority of the said combined district.
4. The number of representatives of each constituent district or combined district of the Hawke's Bay Electric Power District on the Hawke's Bay Electric Power Board shall be the number specified in the Schedule hereto opposite the name of that constituent district or combined district.
5. The first election of the representatives of the said combined district shall be held on the date of the said next general election.
6. The Order in Council dated the 2nd day of October 1956 and published in the *Gazette* on the 4th day of the same month at page 1354, reapportioning representation on the Hawke's Bay Electric Power Board, is hereby revoked.

6. The Order in Council dated the 24th day of April 1929 and published in the *Gazette* on the same day, apportioning representation on the Cambridge Electric Power Board, is hereby revoked.
