PURSUANT to the Local Government Commission Act 1953, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. On and from the 1st day of November 1959, the Buckley Drainage District is hereby abolished and the Buckley Drainage Board is hereby dissolved.

2. On and from the date aforesaid all the property, debts, liabilities, and engagements of the Buckley Drainage Board shall vest in and become the property, debts, liabilities, and engagements of the Manawatu Catchment Board.

3. Subject as otherwise provided herein, the abolition of the Buckley Drainage District shall be deemed to have been effected under the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941 and the Land Drainage Act 1908.
