

Allocating Land Taken for Railway Purposes at Green Island to the Purposes of a Street

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 226 of the Public Works Act 1928, I, Charles John, Viscount Cobham, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto shall, upon the publication hereof in the *Gazette*, become a street and that the said street shall be under the control of the Green Island Borough Council and shall be maintained by the said Council in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said Council.
