SOUTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT

ALL that portion of road situated in Blocks XII and XVI, Maketu Survey District, Tauranga County, commencing at the westernmost corner of Section 15, Block XVI, Maketu Survey District and proceeding thence in a north-easterly direction generally for a distance of approximately 228 chains and terminating at its junction with a public road; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked P.W.D. 160673 (S.O. 38614) deposited in the office of the Minister of Works at Wellington, and thereon coloured red and marked A-B.
